Task:

Weebly Instructions (Directions are for web-based; app will be similar)

- Log into your weebly and click Edit
- Click the tab at the top of the page (blue) where it reads "Pages"
- Find the appropriate page you are going to be working on (Performance Tasks → Unit 2)
- Change the title of your page from "Unit 2" to "Unit 2 Cancer Infographic"
- Change your header on this page to read "Cancer Infographic" and add an appropriate background picture
- Click the "SAVE" button in the upper right corner
- Click the tab at the top of the page (blue) where it reads "Build"
- On the left hand side, drag the "Image" template to where you would like it on your page. Click this template and replace with your infographic that you have created.
- On the left hand side, drag the "Title" template and rename the title to "Reflection". Then underneath, drag a "Text" template. This is where you will type your reflection piece.
- Add a "Button" template to this page. Click the button you added, and where it says "Link" paste the website where you published your infographic. Change the text on the button to read "Website".
- **IMPORTANT** When finished, be sure to click the orange "PUBLISH" button in the upper right corner. If you do not, any changes you have made since your last log-in will not be saved.
 - If using ipad app, you will need to click "Preview" in the upper right and then publish.
- Any other design elements you add to your weebly are optional.
